## Event description

- **Hungarian Middle Distance Championship:** daytime, middle distance, individual race (one round, without qualification), World Ranking Event (WRE) in M/W21E classes
- **Hungarian Relay Championship:** relay race with the participation of 3 team members in all classes.

## Event programme

- 06 June 2026 (Saturday) – Hungarian Middle Distance Championship, planned first start: 12:00
- 07 June 2026 (Sunday) – Hungarian Relay Championship, planned first start: 10:00

## Classes

### Hungarian Middle Distance Championship:

- M/W 14E, 16E, 18E, 20E, 21E, 35A, 40A, 45A, 50A, 55A, 60A, 65A, 70A, 75A, 80A, F85A
- NON – championship classes – M/W14B, Open Beginner, Open Advanced

### Hungarian Relay Championship:

- M/W14A, 16A, 18A, 20A, 21A, 105A, 135A, 165A, 185A, F205A
- NON – championship classes – Open Beginner, Open Advanced (individual race with mass start)

Competitors in the M/W 21E classes who wish to run for WRE points must also enter via the IOF Eventor at the following link: <https://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/8708>

With the exception of the open classes, all competitors must hold either an annual or a day competition licence issued by the Hungarian Orienteering Federation (HOF). The entry system checks the validity of the annual licence at the time of entry; if it is missing, the fee for the day competition licence will be automatically charged.

Anyone may enter the championship, however, only Hungarian citizens and Hungarian clubs are included in the results of the Hungarian Championships

## Entry deadline

Championship classes (both Middle & Relay): **25 May 2026**

Open classes: **31 May 2026**

After the deadline, we will accept entries only in the non-championship classes.

Relay team line-ups must be submitted by name through the online entry system, no later than **08:00 on 7 June 2026**.

In addition to the listed entry fees, competitors who do not hold a HOF annual competition license are required to pay a daily competition license fee of **2,300 HUF** per event, when competing in championship classes. **The online registration system will automatically add this fee to the entry fee.**

## Payment

By bank transfer or by credit/debit card via the online registration system, based on the invoice issued before the competition. **Submitting an entry entails a payment obligation!** After the draw, entries cannot be cancelled even in the open classes (compensation is only possible by submitting a new entry or by changing the name).

## Terrain

The competition terrain has a mid-mountain character, typical of the Southern Bakony region, with elevations between 200 and 400 meters above sea level. The relief is mainly defined by steep slopes, valleys, and in places exceptionally detailed surface features. The vegetation is diverse: in addition to well-runnable, well-visible forests, there are also pine forests with dense vegetation and undergrowth that significantly restrict both running speed and visibility. In some areas, dense brambles make running more difficult.

The terrain is characterized by a moderately dense to sparse path network.

## Maps

### Hungarian Middle Distance Championship

- M/W14 – M/W50 classes – 1:10.000/5m
- M/W55 and above – 1:7.500/5m

### Hungarian Relay Championship

- **M/WN14 – M/W145 classes – 1:10.000/5m**
- **M/W165 and above – 1:7.500/5m**

## Embargoed area

The area affected by the competition is among the embargoed areas of the World Orienteering Championships 2027 (WOC 2027). Therefore, by decision of the WOC 2027 Organising Committee, access to the area was restricted already before this Bulletin 1 was published.

The WOC 2027 terrain restrictions also apply to the Hungarian Middle Distance & Relay Championship 2026, as described below.

- For competitors, team officials and others who, through knowledge of the terrain or the competitions, may influence the results of the competitions, it is prohibited to enter the embargoed area.

## Punching system

The competition will use the SPORTIdent electronic punching system. The contactless (Air+) mode will be enabled for both races.

Traditional SI cards can be rented on-site for 500 HUF per race, and contactless (SIAC) cards for 800 HUF per race. Competitors born in 2012 or later may rent traditional SI cards free of charge.

## Accommodation, transportation

Accommodation options will be published later in the HOF database. No organized transportation is planned, but if requested in advance, we will arrange transport to the competition centre.

## Prizes

The winners of each class will be awarded the title of Hungarian Middle Distance Champion or Hungarian Relay Champion. Competitors placing 1st to 3rd will receive a medal and a prize, while those placing 4th to 6th in the M/W 14–21 classes will receive a certificate (middle distance only). No awards ceremony will be held for the open classes.

**Only Hungarian citizens can place in the Hungarian championship classes. Foreign competitors and foreign relay teams will receive a certificate and a prize.**

## Other information

- Participation in the competition is at each participant's own risk.
- Any commercial activity during the event is only allowed with prior permission from the organizing committee.
- Participants (competitors, team officials, spectators) accept that photos and videos taken during the competition may be published in print or online media, including on the internet, unless a written statement to the contrary is provided


