
## Terrain

### **Kiskunhalas – Kertváros**

Varied sprint terrain with residential streets, small parks, a school yard and apartment block areas. The terrain includes several fenced but open courtyards forming a complex labyrinth. A small urban forest with channels also creates interesting route choices.

### **Kakas-hegy**


Typical Great Hungarian Plain terrain with sandy dunes (6–10 m high). The area includes open and semi-open terrain with bushes, well-runnable pine forests, young planted forest areas with reduced runnability, and mixed forests. Forestry activity has created some recent clearings. The road network is relatively dense, and vegetation boundaries are frequent.




## Embargoed Areas



Open / D / DK categories:

2,000 HUF per stage

SI card rental: 500 HUF per stage (free for M/W10–14).

Air+ SIAC rental: 800 HUF per stage.

Competitors without a Hungarian competition license must pay a daily license fee of 1,200 HUF per stage.

## **Payment**

Clubs: by bank transfer based on invoice sent after entries close (13 May 2026).

Individuals: by bank card in the entry system or cash on site.

Entries imply an obligation to pay the entry fee.

After invoices are issued, cancellations and refunds are not possible.

## **Punching System**

SPORTident punching system will be used.

Control units will operate in AIR+ mode.

## **Transport**

No official transport is planned.

Participants are encouraged to organise transport via the “Tájfutó telekocsi” Facebook group.

## **Accommodation**

Dormitory accommodation in Kiskunhalas:

6,500 HUF / person / night

Gymnasium accommodation:  
2,500 HUF / person / night  
Exact location will be announced later.

Other accommodation must be arranged individually.

## Parking

Kiskunhalas: parking according to local traffic regulations (free on weekends).

Kakas-hegy (Stages 2–3):  
1,000 HUF / car / 2 days
