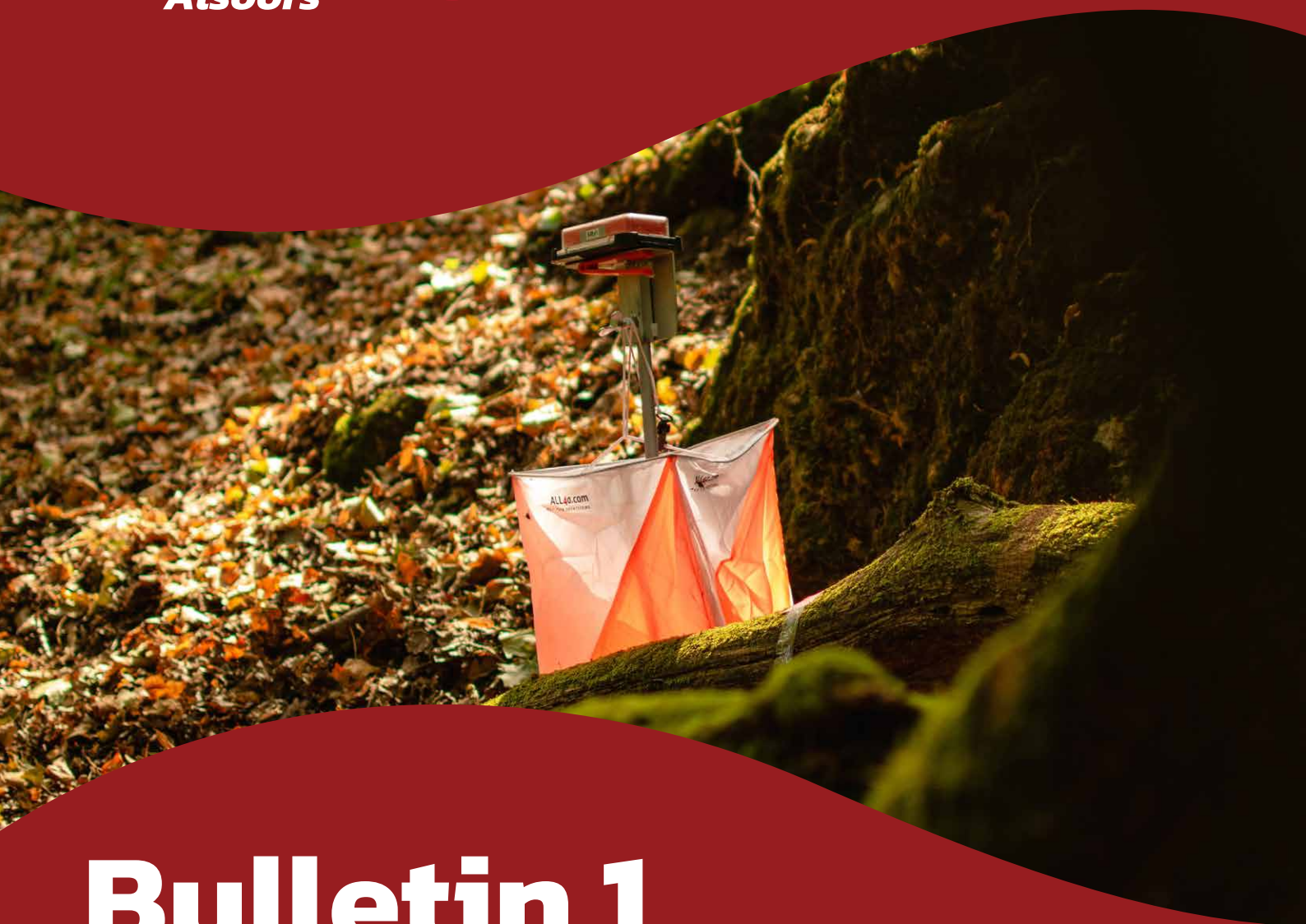

## Event description

Two-round individual competition, with middle distance races on both days and overall classification based on combined results.

In the M/W21E classes, both races are IOF Gold WRE (World Ranking Event) competitions.

## Programme

- 3 October 2026 (Saturday) – Honvéd Cup Day 1 – middle distance (IOF Gold WRE), planned first start: 12:00
- 4 October 2026 (Sunday) – Honvéd Cup Day 2 – middle distance (IOF Gold WRE), planned first start: 10:00

## Classes

- M/W 10D, 12C, 14E, 16E, 18E, 15–18C, 20E, 21E, 21Br, 21C, 35A, 40A, 45A, 50A, 55A, 60A, 65A, 70A, 75A, M80A,
- **Open classes:** Open Beginner (OB), Open Advanced (OA)

**If the number of entries in the M21E and W21E classes exceeds 90, the elite categories will be divided into two separate groups. The division will be based on the athletes' current positions in the IOF Foot Orienteering World Ranking.**

The expected winning time in M21E and W21E classes is **32–35 minutes in both races.**

## Entries

With the exception of the open classes, all competitors must hold either an annual or a daily competition licence issued by the Hungarian Orienteering Federation (HOF). The entry system checks the validity of the annual licence at the time of entry; if it is missing, the fee for the day competition licence will be automatically charged.

In addition to the listed entry fees, competitors who do not hold a HOF annual competition license are required to **pay a daily competition license fee of 1.200 HUF per race** (except Open, and M/W10D classes). **The online registration system will automatically add this fee to the entry fee.**

## Payment

By bank transfer or by credit/debit card via the online registration system, based on the invoice issued after the competition. **Submitting an entry entails a payment obligation!** After the draw, entries cannot be cancelled even in the open classes (compensation is only possible by submitting a new entry or by changing the name).

## Terrain

The competition terrain is located in the Balaton Uplands, in the area bounded by Alsóörs, Felsőörs, and Balatonalmádi, at an elevation of 180 to 300 meters above sea level.

The vegetation is varied: alongside well-runnable forests, there are also areas with dense vegetation that significantly restrict both running speed and visibility.

Runnability is further reduced in several places by extensive stony and broken grounds, formed during the extraction of the region's characteristic red sandstone.

The relief is also made more diverse by traces of former mining activities, resulting in numerous point-like terrain features throughout the area.

The terrain is characterized by a moderately dense network of paths, a significant part of which are officially marked hiking trails.

## Maps

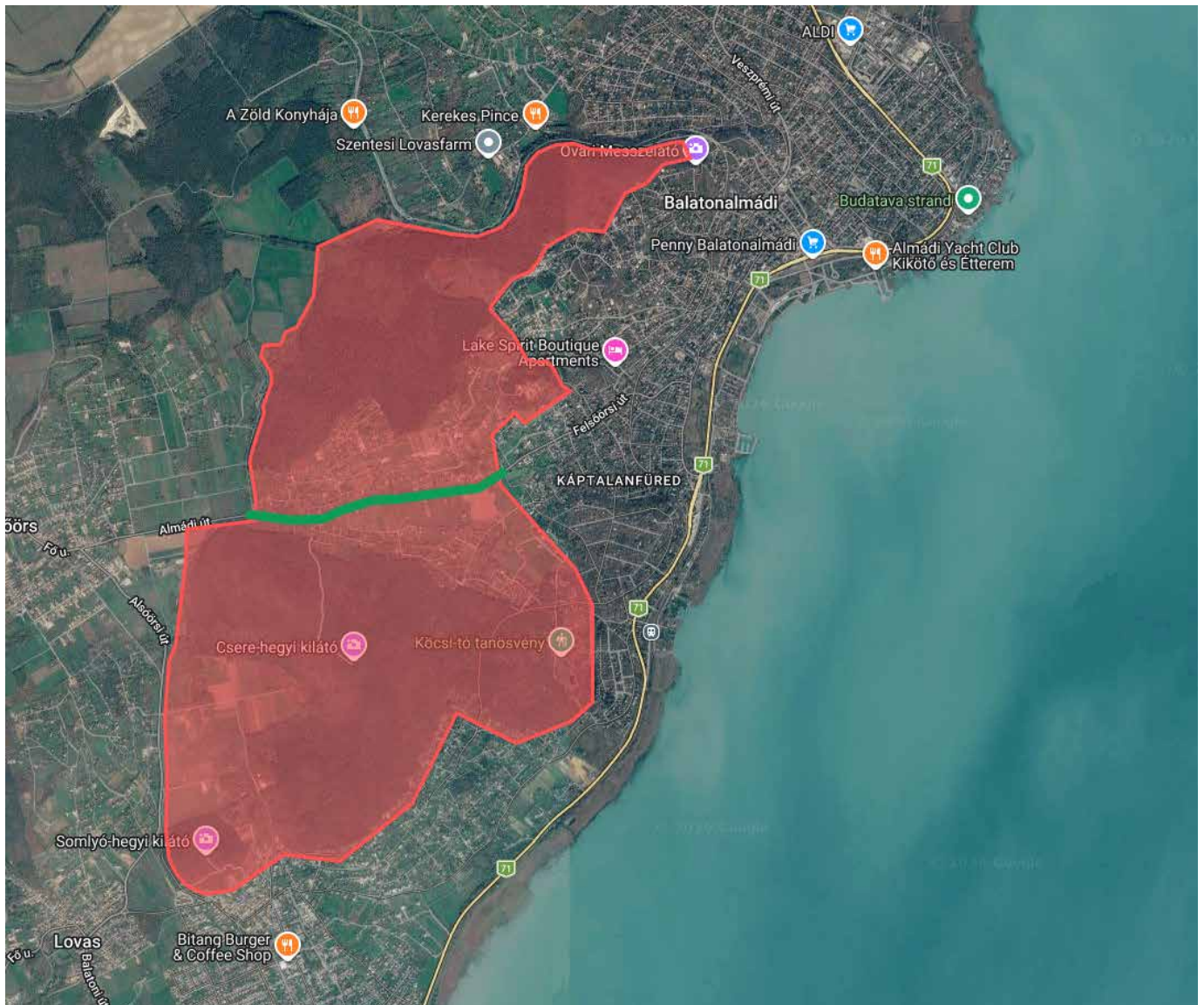
- M/W10D – M/W50 classes – 1:10.000/5m
- M/W55 and above – 1:7.500/5m

## Embargoed area

From the publication of the Bulletin 1 until the day of the competition, it is strictly forbidden for athletes intending to participate in the Honvéd Cup 2026 and their coaches to enter the area marked on the map sketch. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification from the competition.

Entry is also prohibited for anyone else who could influence the competition by passing on knowledge of the terrain.

### **Punching system**

The competition will use the SPORTIdent electronic punching system. The contactless (Air+) mode will be enabled for both races. Traditional SI cards can be rented on-site for 500 HUF per race, and contactless (SIAC) cards for 800 HUF per race. Competitors born in 2012 or later may rent traditional SI cards free of charge.

### **Accommodation, transportation**

Accommodation options will be published later in the [HOF database](#). No organized transportation is planned, but if requested in advance, we will arrange transport to the competition centre.

Additionally, a wide range of accommodation options offered for the WOC training camps is available on the World Orienteering Championships [website](#).

### **Car rental**

Participants of WOC 2027 training activities may benefit from a special agreement with Sixt.

A 15% discount is available on standard online rental rates under the following conditions:

- Validity: At Sixt locations worldwide
- Application: The discount is applied to the online rental price at the time of booking
- Exclusions: The discount does not apply to additional services or extras

### **Prizes**

The overall 1–3 place finishers of the Honvéd Cup (and the 1–6 place finishers in the M/W21E categories) will receive medals and other prizes.

The 1–6 place finishers of the IOF Gold WRE races will also be awarded in a separate prize-giving ceremony.

### **Visa permits**

According to current regulations, citizens of certain countries are required to obtain a visa to enter the European Union. EU nationals do not require a visa to enter Hungary.

Other travelers may need a Hungarian visa depending on their nationality. For details on visa exemptions and entry requirements, visit the Hungarian Ministry of Foreign Affairs website: <https://konzinfo.mfa.gov>.

## Climate, clothing, hazards

In Hungary, the average temperature at the beginning of October is around 15–20 °C, no special conditions are expected.

There might be ticks in the forest, so check your skin and clothing after training and competition. Ticks might transmit Lyme-disease and Meningoencephalitis.

There are no restrictions on clothing. Spike shoes are forbidden. Dobb shoes and dobb shoes with metal studs are allowed

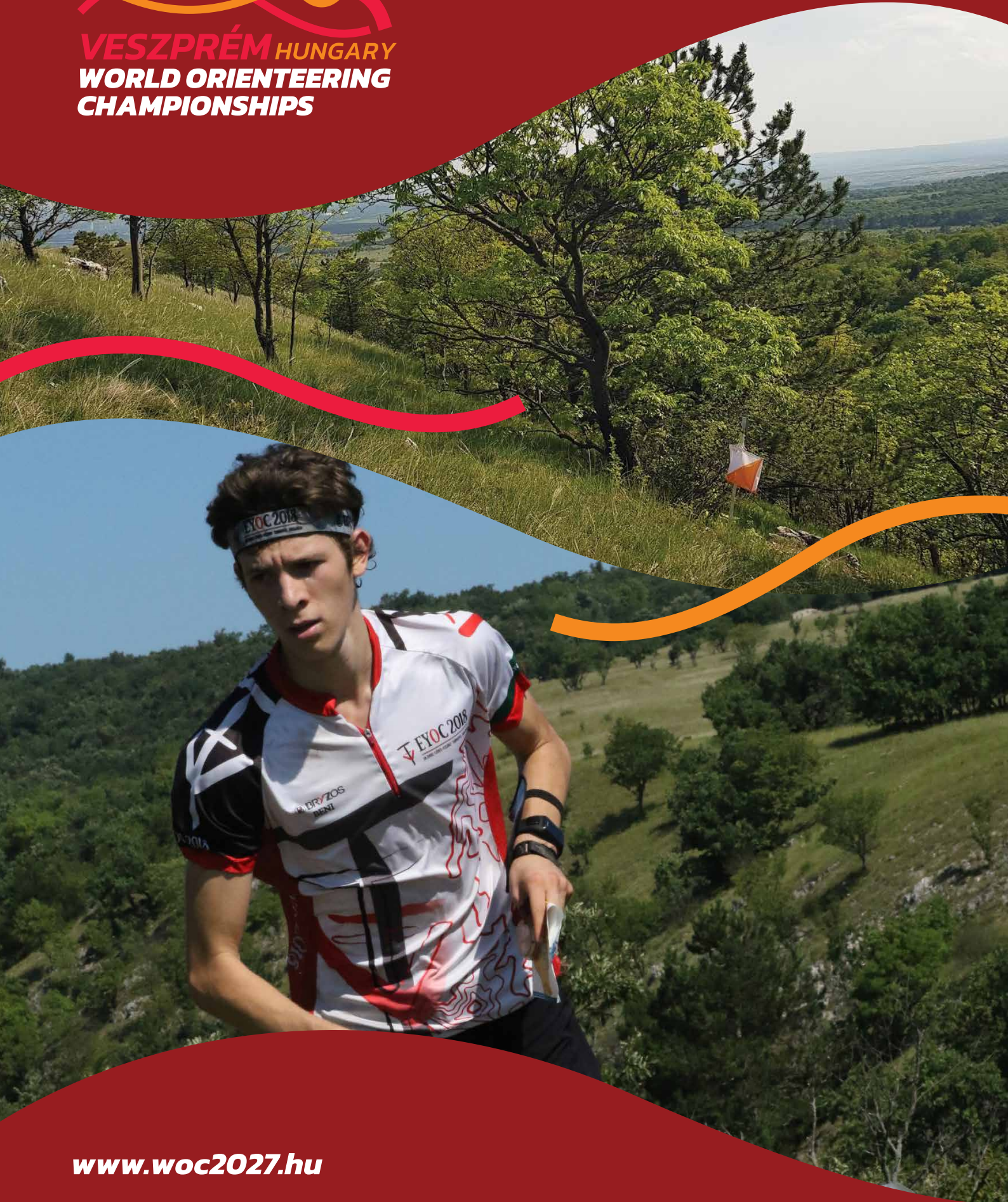
